This is an example of how to set up Tipasa as a GES in Alma. Your own set-up may differ.

Alma role needed to set up GES: General System Administrator or Fulfillment Administrator

1. Go to: Alma Configuration > Fulfillment > Discovery Interface Display Logic > General Electronic Services. Make sure you are configuring at the **INSTITUTION LEVEL**



2. Select "Add Service" from the General Electronic Services page

 - c. Service description: Add a description, if you wish, such as: Interlibrary loan service for articles or Interlibrary loan requests for films
 - d. Public Name: Add a public name, if you wish, such as: Request through Interlibrary Loan
 - e. Is this a Document Delivery/ILL Service? Set to "Yes"
 - f. Display Location: Select "Getit & How To Getit"
