

Assessing Copyright Clearance Center's *Get it Now* Service

Data from July 2012 – October 2013

Library Environment

- Student/faculty population = approx. 6,000.
- Heavily used Interlibrary Loan Services for library this size.
- Before we added *Get It Now*, we purchased approximately \$15,000/year articles direct from publishers.
 - Averaged \$34/article for 2012/2013.
- Had deposit account with Elsevier at start of our access to *Get It Now*, \$25/article.
- Cut library materials budget approx. 28% over last two fiscal years.

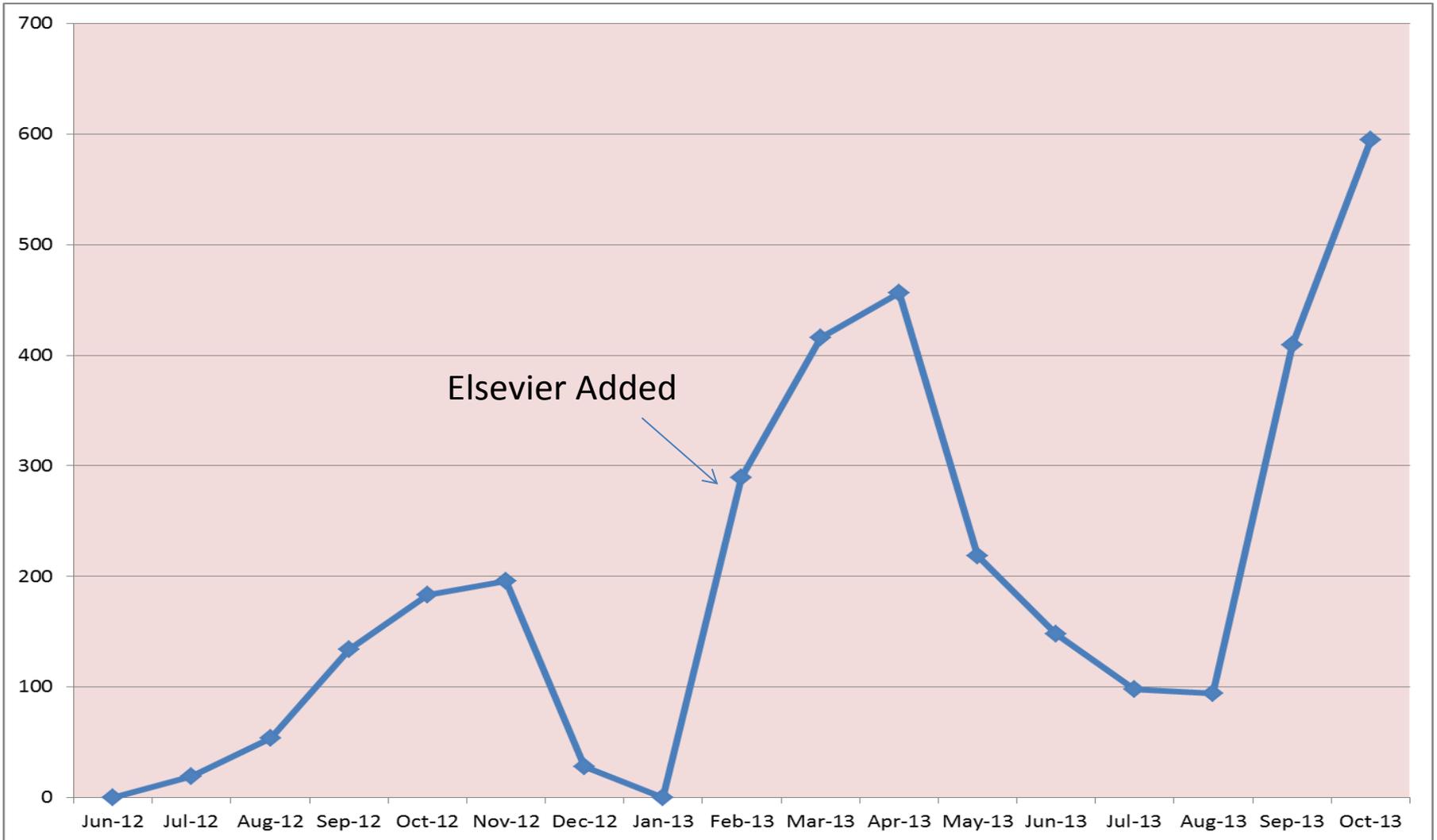
What is *Get It Now*?

- An article purchase-per-use service for multiple publishers which is incorporated into link resolvers (SFX or Serials Solutions, etc.)
- Links from databases ONLY for those article titles/years we DO NOT have any access to.
- Required minor SFX programming on our part, quick set up.
- Competitively priced with direct purchases from pub.
- Access to over 9,000 articles from 87 publishers.

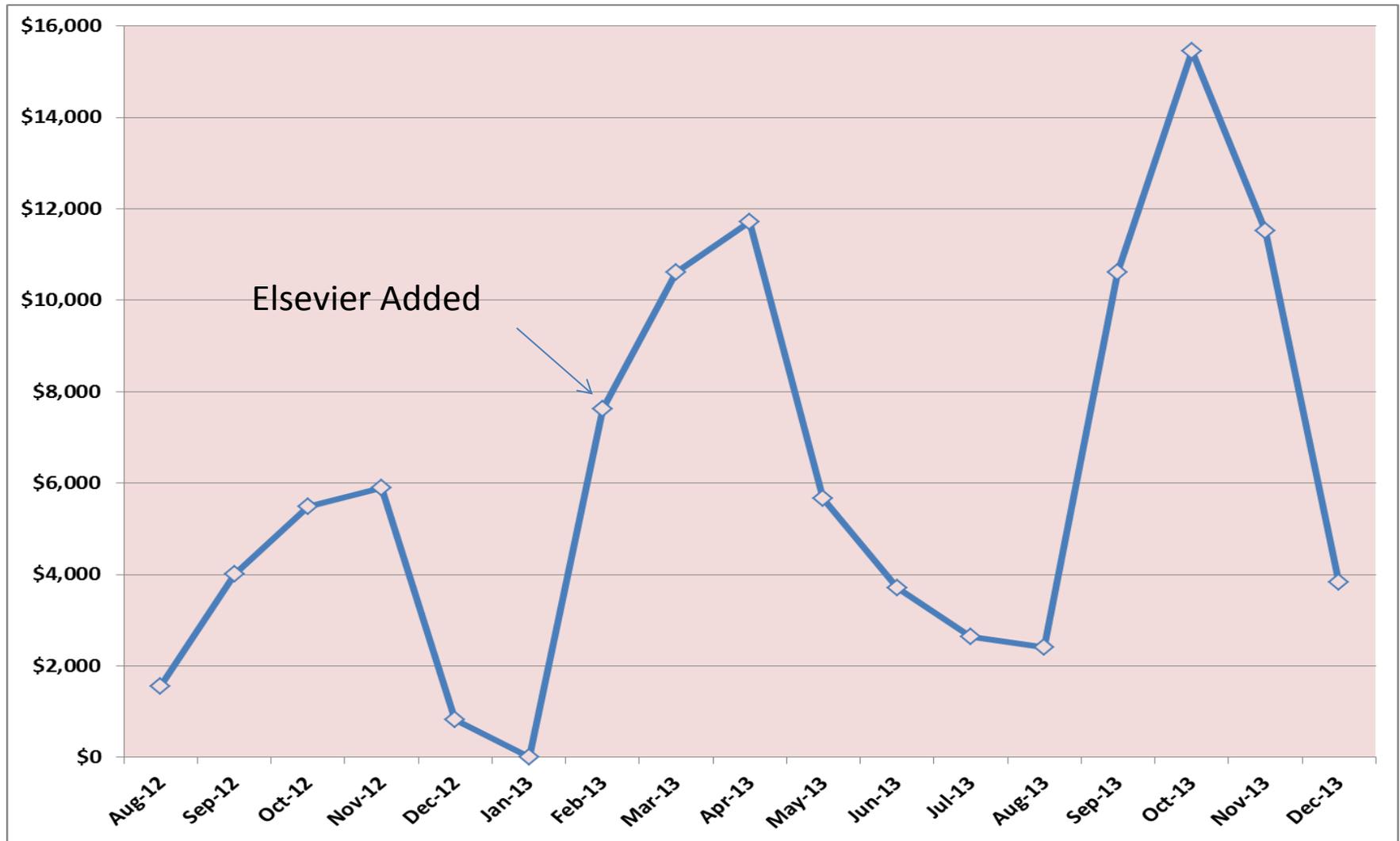

- What YEARS OF PUBLICATION are used the most?

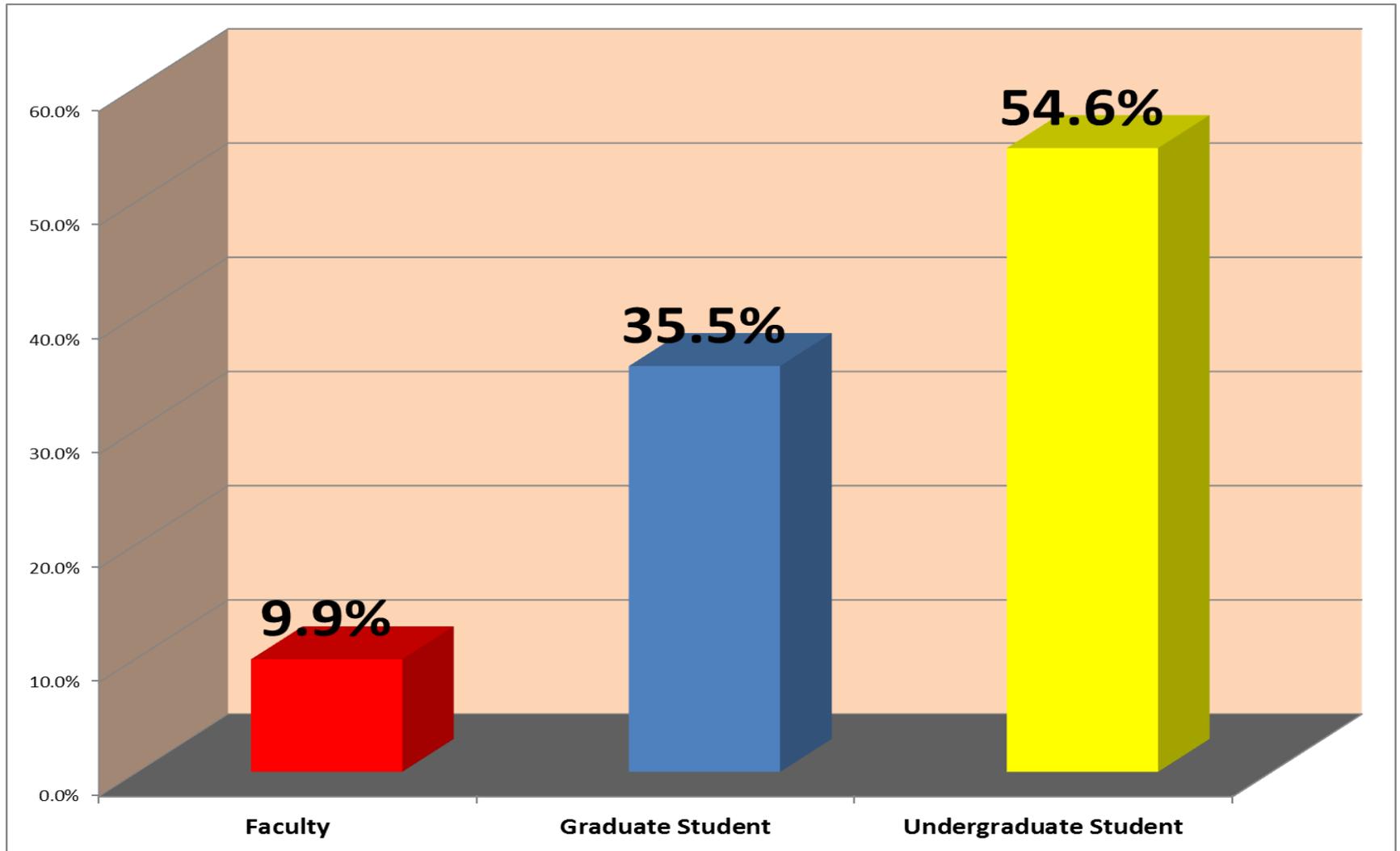
Is it BEING USED?

Summary of User Data

- In 16 months, **3,338 total orders** were placed by **915 different users** (e-mail addresses). Each user averages **3 orders**. Only **36 different faculty members** used the service.
- **43% of users (392)** ordered only 1 item in 12 months.
- Only **25 users (or 2.7%)** requested 16 or more articles (1 per month).
 - **NUR/PT** are some of heaviest users.
 - **ME, BIO** and others also listed.
 - **18 graduate students (72%)** and **4 faculty members** were among the heaviest users. Only **3 undergraduates** were.

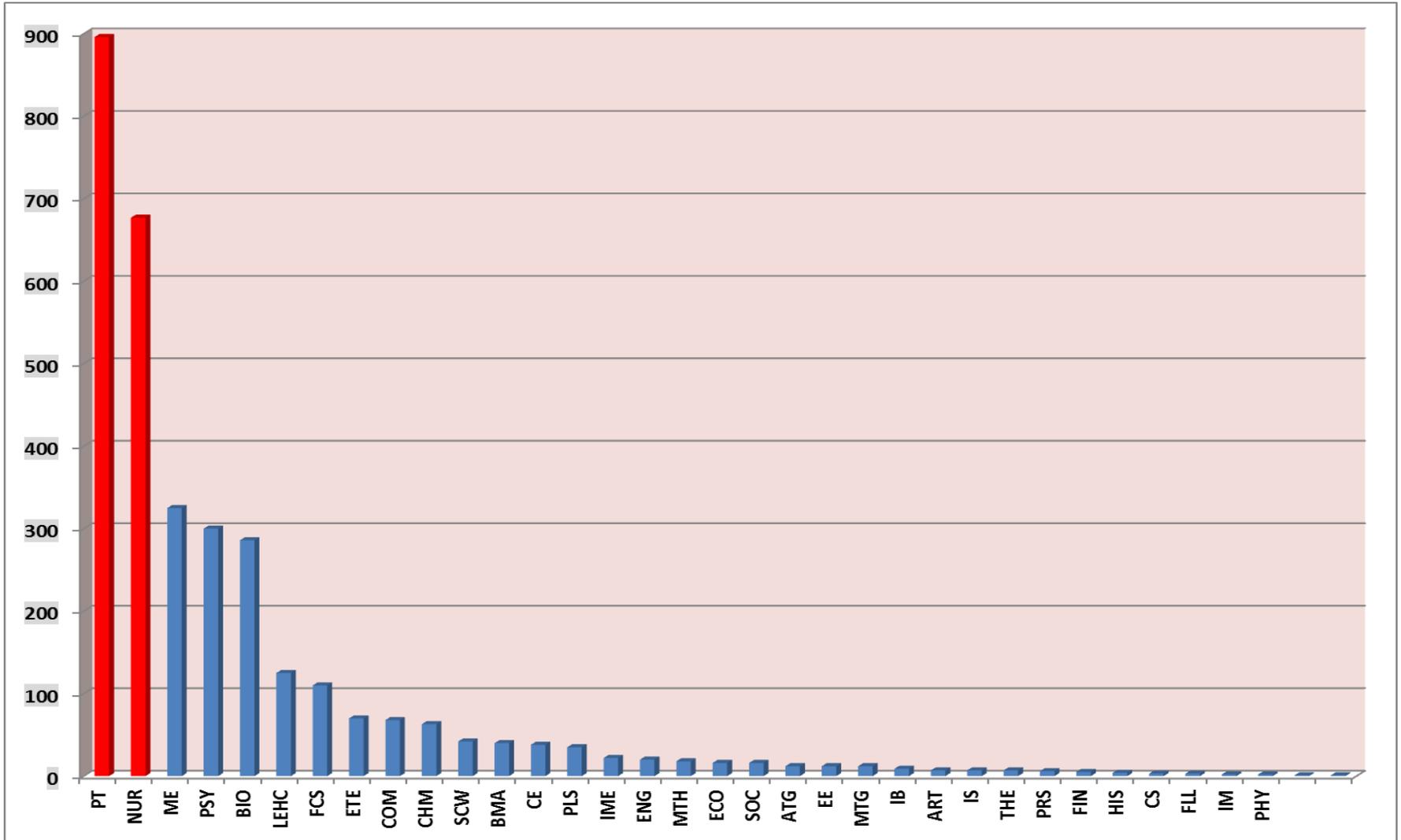

Summary of User Data

- Looking at campus population:
 - Undergraduates order more overall but graduate students order more on average.
 - Graduate students average 1.8 per FTE.
 - Faculty members average .7 per FTE.
 - Undergraduates average .3 per FTE.
- 13.5% of graduate students have used service.
- 5.4% of faculty members have used service.
- 2.7% of undergraduates have used service.

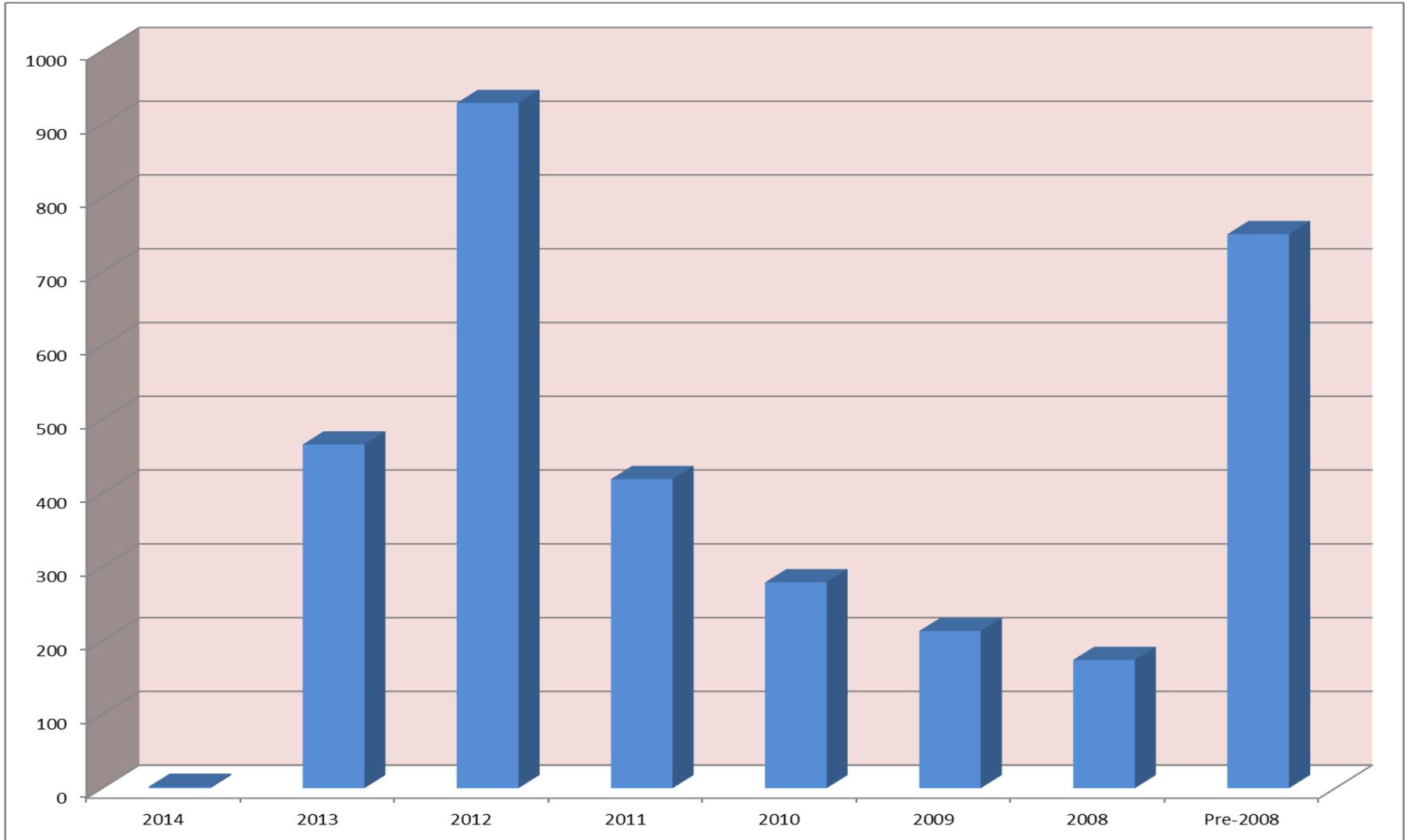

Which JOURNALS are used the most?

- British Journal of Sports Medicine – BMJ Pub. (\$30)– 46 orders – PT
- Journal of Bodywork & Movement Therapies – Elsevier (\$24) – 42 orders - PT
- Disability & Rehabilitation – Informa HealthCare (\$37)– 38 orders – PT
- Social Science & Medicine – Elsevier (\$24/article) – 33 orders - NUR/PT
- Personality and Individual Differences – Elsevier (\$24/article) – 31 orders - PSY
- Computers in Human Behavior – Elsevier (\$24/article) – 28 orders – SOC?/PSY?/CS?
- Majority are Nursing/PT titles.

What YEARS OF PUBLICATION are used the most?

75% of ordered articles have copyrights after 2008



Summary

- At 55% of the total, **undergraduates** are the heaviest users of Get-It-Now but **graduate students** order more per FTE.
- Only **915 users** placed orders.
- **43%** of all users ordered only 1 article.
- **25 users** ordered more than 16 articles in 16 months. **18** of them were graduate students.
- 47% of the use is from the **Physical Therapy/ Nursing Depts.**
- **Elsevier** is the most highly ordered publisher by far.
- We pay **\$26.54** per article on average.
- Several journal titles are heavily used, the vast majority are for **PT/Nursing** .
- **75%** of the orders are from journal issues published in the past **six years**.
